MEMBERSHIP CRITERIA AND PRIVILEGES TAKEN FROM THE 2011 CONSTITUTION

ORDINARY MEMBERS (BOWLING)

- 1.1 Ordinary members (Bowling) shall be persons who have attained the age of eighteen (18) years and are elected or transferred to Ordinary member (Bowling) membership of the Club.
- 1.2 Ordinary members (Bowling) shall be affiliated members of the Royal New South Wales Bowling Association or the New South Wales Women's Bowling Association depending upon gender.
- 1.3 Ordinary members (Bowling) are entitled to:
 - (a) such playing and social privileges and advantages of the Club as may be determined by the Board from time to time; and
 - (b) attend and vote at general meetings (including Annual General Meetings) of the Club;
 - (c) subject to Rule **Error! Reference source not found.**, nominate for and be elected to hold office on the Board;
 - (d) vote in the election of the Board;
 - (e) vote on any Special Resolution (including a Special Resolution to amend this Constitution);
 - (f) propose, second, or nominate any eligible member for any office of the Club;
 - (g) propose, second or nominate any eligible member for Life membership;
 - (h) introduce guests to the Club.

ORDINARY MEMBERS (NON-BOWLING)

- 1.4 Ordinary members (Non-Bowling) shall be persons who have attained the age of eighteen (18) years and are elected or transferred to Ordinary member (Non-Bowling) membership of the Club.
- 1.5 Ordinary members (Non-Bowling) are entitled to:
 - (a) such playing and social privileges and advantages of the Club as may be determined by the Board from time to time; and
 - (b) subject to rule 10,12 below, attend and vote at general meetings (including Annual General Meetings) of the Club;
 - (c) subject to rule 27, nominate for and be elected to hold office on the Board;
 - (d) propose, second, or nominate any eligible member for any office of the Club;
 - (e) propose, second or nominate any eligible member for Life membership;
 - (f) introduce guests to the Club.
- 1.6 Ordinary members (Non-Bowling) are not entitled to vote on any Special Resolution to amend this Constitution.

JUNIOR MEMBERS

- 1.7 Junior members shall be persons who have not attained the age of eighteen (18) years and are elected to Junior membership of the Club.
- 1.8 A person shall not be admitted as a Junior member of the Club unless the Board:
 - (a) is satisfied that the person is of sufficient maturity to meet the requirements for participation in the sport of the respective Sub-Club the Junior applies to join.
 - (b) is satisfied that the person is joining the Club for the purposes of playing sport as a member of the Club or a Sub club; and
 - (c) has received from that persons parent or guardian written consent to that person becoming a Junior member of the Club and taking part in the sporting activities organised by the Club or a Sub club;
 - (d) is satisfied that the person will take part in regular sporting activities organised by the Club or a Sub club.
- 1.9 Subject to the provisions of the Registered Clubs Act, Junior members are entitled to such playing and social privileges and advantages of the Club as may be determined by the Board from time to time but shall not be entitled to:
 - (a) attend or vote at general meetings (including Annual General Meetings) of the Club;
 - (b) nominate for or be elected to hold office on the Board;
 - (c) vote in the election of the Board;
 - (d) vote on any Special Resolution (including a Special Resolution to amend this Constitution);
 - (e) propose, second or nominate any eligible member for any office of the Club;
 - (f) propose, second or nominate any eligible member for Life membership;
 - (g) introduce guests to the Club.

PROVISIONAL MEMBERSHIP

- 1.10 A person in respect of whom:
 - (a) a nomination form for membership duly completed in accordance with this Constitution has been given to the Club; and
 - (b) who has paid to the Club the joining fee (if any) and the subscription appropriate to the class of membership referred to in the nomination form,may be granted Provisional membership of the Club while awaiting the decision of the Board in relation to that person's application for membership of the Club.
- 1.11 Should a person who is admitted as a Provisional member not be elected to membership of the Club within six (6) weeks from the date of the nomination form being given to the Secretary or should that person's application for membership be refused (whichever is the sooner):
 - (a) that person shall cease to be a Provisional member of the Club; and
 - (b) the joining fee (if any) and subscription submitted with the nomination shall be returned to that person.
- 1.12 Provisional members are entitled to:
 - (a) such playing and social privileges and advantages of the Club as the Board may determine from time to time; and
 - (b) introduce guests into the Club if the Provisional member is an applicant for a class of membership which is permitted to do so.
- 1.13 Provisional members are not entitled to:
 - (a) attend or vote at general meetings of the Club; or
 - (b) nominate for or be elected to hold office on the Board;
 - (c) vote in the election of the Board;
 - (d) vote on any Special Resolution (including a Special Resolution to amend this Constitution);
 - (e) propose, second, or nominate any eligible member for any office of the Club;
 - (f) propose, second or nominate any eligible member for Life membership.
